ESSENTIAL MINIMUM CRITERIA

- 1 PhD in oenology, viticulture, food science or other relevant discipline.
- 2 No less than 3 years postdoctoral experience in a relevant research-active role.
- 3 A research publication record in peered review journals commensurate with ~4 year PhD and 3+ years postdoctoral experience.
- 4 Research student supervision and project management skills.
- 5 Excellent communication skills and a demonstrated ability to effectively work in research teams comprised of university, research institute and industry personnel.
- 6 Highly developed computer skills relevant to research field.
- 7 An ability to travel to work with regional and interstate participant organisations (esp. Charles Sturt University), at times for periods of several months (e.g. during vintage), which would require temporary relocation.
- 8 Current drivers licence.

DESIRABLE CHARACTERISTICS

- 1 Evidence of having developed and maintained productive working relationships with the wine industry, preferably in Australia
- 2 Experience in the conduct of viticultural trials concluding with small or commercial scale winemaking, and chemical and sensory analysis.
- 3 Experience in translating wine research finding to information modules for communication with industry practitioners
