It is a pleasure to invite you to the inauguration of EFI's Project Center "Supporting the Global Implementation of REDD and FLEGT (SURF) on Wednesday March, 26 at the University of Hamburg.

EFI-SURF is an initiative of the European Forest Institute (EFI) jointly organised by the University of Hamburg and the University of Leuven. The Project Center is focusing on the global initiatives "Reducing Emissions from Deforestation and Forest Degradation (REDD)" and "Forest Law Enforcement for Governance and Trade (FLEGT)"

EFI-SURF will support the sustainable management of tropical forests and the abatement of illegal logging by engaging researchers from forest, social and environmental sciences in collaborations that encompass researchers from all EFI member institutions.

EFI-SURF works with affiliated scientists in order to carry out joint exploration of strategies in the scope of REDD and FLEGT.

EFI-SURF initiates research activities in emerging fields of climate change mitigation, sustainable forest management, prevention of illegal logging and the trade in illegal timber in order to develop science based approaches of measurement, reporting and validation, design of REDD+ and FLEGT mechanisms, assessment of socio-political situations and certification in a multi-disciplinary environment.

EFI-SURF enters into research and development projects in collaboration with international partners, having a application-centered perspective drawing on qualitative, processual as well as quantitative methods.

EFI-SURF coordinates activities and collaborations both at the University of Hamburg and at the University of Leuven and serves as a platform for EFI member institutions.
